Romans 8:1-17

Justification → Sanctification = No Condemnation: By the Spirit You Will Live, Just as by the Flesh You Die

(Solution to 7:7-25; Parallel to 5:12-21)

KJV

1 <u>There is therefore now no condemnation</u> to them which are in Christ Jesus,

who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, <u>God</u> sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, <u>condemned sin in the flesh: 4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.</u>

5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. 6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. 7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. 8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

9But <u>ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit</u>, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

8:1-11: The Spirit of Life Frees Those in Christ from Sin and Condemnation (the Sentence of Death)

8:1-2: Thesis – We face no condemnation, for the Spirit frees us from the law of sin and death

8:3-11: Explanation – Flesh-living versus Spirit-living

In Christ's sacrifice, God condemned sin in the flesh; now the Spirit can fulfill the Law's requirements in us (3-4)

Two kinds of living: fleshliving brings certain death, but Spirit-living brings life and peace (5-8)

All you who belong to God are freed from flesh-living, because you have the Spirit (9)

Therefore He will give you life, just as He raised Christ from the dead (10-11)

ESV

1 There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

3 For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, 4 in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. 6 For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace. 7 For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. 8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him.

10 But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.
