What is saving faith *fully convinced* about?

[Righteousness] will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification. (Romans 4:24-25, ESV).

- 1. God—He keeps his promises.
- 2. God has provided the way that I can become righteous.
 - → I have done bad deeds.
 - → My deeds matter; bad deeds are deadly.
 - → Apart from Christ, I am not in right standing with God.
 - → Apart from Christ, I will receive God's wrath.
 - → Jesus died: His death is God's plan for dealing with my sins.
 - → Jesus rose: His resurrection is God's way to give me right standing with Him.
 - Jesus is my Lord—master, boss, ruler—possessing all power and authority, and deserving all my obedience.



"<u>Original righteousness</u>":

Christ frees us more certainly and completely than Adam left us bound!



7:13-25	Does the Law Cause Our Death? No, Sin Does. The Law Drives Us to Christ
7:13	Sin is shown to be utterly sinful because it uses the good Law to kill us
7:14-23	Our inability to keep the Law reveals sin is inside our flesh, binding us
7:24-25a	The resulting wretchedness drives us to Christ, who frees us from death
7:25b	Conclusion: With your mind serve the Law of God, or with your flesh the law of sin
